

All One-On-One Options

One-on-one classes are given year-round, provide the greatest degree of scheduling flexibility, and can be tailored to fit the goals of the student. If you prefer one-on-one classes, you may take a course with a set number of classes, or you may schedule and pay by the class. Students who wish to prepare for only one or two of the three subjects, Math, Critical Reading, or Writing usually take private classes by the hour.

Option 1: All Private Course with 200 Point Score Assurance

Features

- 12 hours of one-on-one classes. Each class may be 60 or 90 minutes. Students should allow enough time between classes to complete homework assignments. All classes are given at our office in Wayne to assure a suitable teaching environment.
- A Diagnostic Exam and up to six full-length SAT exams. Exams should be taken at our office whenever possible.
- Includes all Crimson Review materials, including binder, Math Review, vocabulary workbooks with flash cards, exams, topic worksheets, strategy illustrations, and access to website review materials.
- Improve by 200 points (math + critical reading + writing) or we provide 4 more one-on-one classes and 3 additional exams free—you pay nothing for the extra classes, the extra exams, or the extra materials. Student must meet the following requirements to qualify for the free classes: (1) provide score reports from actual SAT or PSAT administrations to establish pre-course and post-course scores; (2) attend all classes and complete and turn in the homework assignments due for that class; (3) pay tuition in full within 24 hours of the first class meeting; (4) give 24 hours notice for any class cancelation or re-scheduling; (5) notify us within 15 days of receipt of scores that the student intends to return for free classes.

Course Fee: \$1,650

The fee covers all classes, exams, and materials. If you decide not to continue after your first class, return the materials, and you will receive a 100% refund. If you stop at any time after the second class, you will receive a prorated refund. Price comparison: If paid separately under Option 2 below, the cost would be \$2,040.

To Get Started with the One-On-One Course with Performance Guarantee

Call to arrange to take the Diagnostic Exam and to schedule the first class.

If the student already has SAT or PSAT scores, the Diagnostic Exam may be taken at our office or at home. If the student does not have SAT or PSAT scores, the exam must be taken at our office to establish a baseline score for the guarantee.

Option 2: Private Classes By The Hour

Take only as many classes as you want. You may set up a schedule in advance and pay for each class when you take it, or schedule classes as you need them. There are no big pre-payments and no long-term commitments. It doesn't get any more flexible.

Fees

- \$135 per hour. (There is a one-time fee of \$45 for materials and study guides.)
- \$35 for test administrations at Crimson Review. (The Diagnostic Exam is free.) Exams are graded and results mailed within seven days. Each student receives the exam booklet, a copy of the graded answer sheet, the answer key, and the completed scoring sheet showing the raw and scaled scores. Students may take these same tests at home free of charge.
- \$40 for a written essay evaluation from our Reader. (First one is free.) \$40 for a 20 minute meeting with our Reader.
- \$50 charge for no-shows and late cancellations. Notice of cancellations must be received by 8:00 PM the day before the class.

To Get Started with Classes By The Hour

To start classes, call to schedule the Diagnostic Exam or to arrange delivery or pickup of the exam. Once the student completes the exam, call to schedule the first class meeting. It is helpful if the exam is returned for grading before the first class.

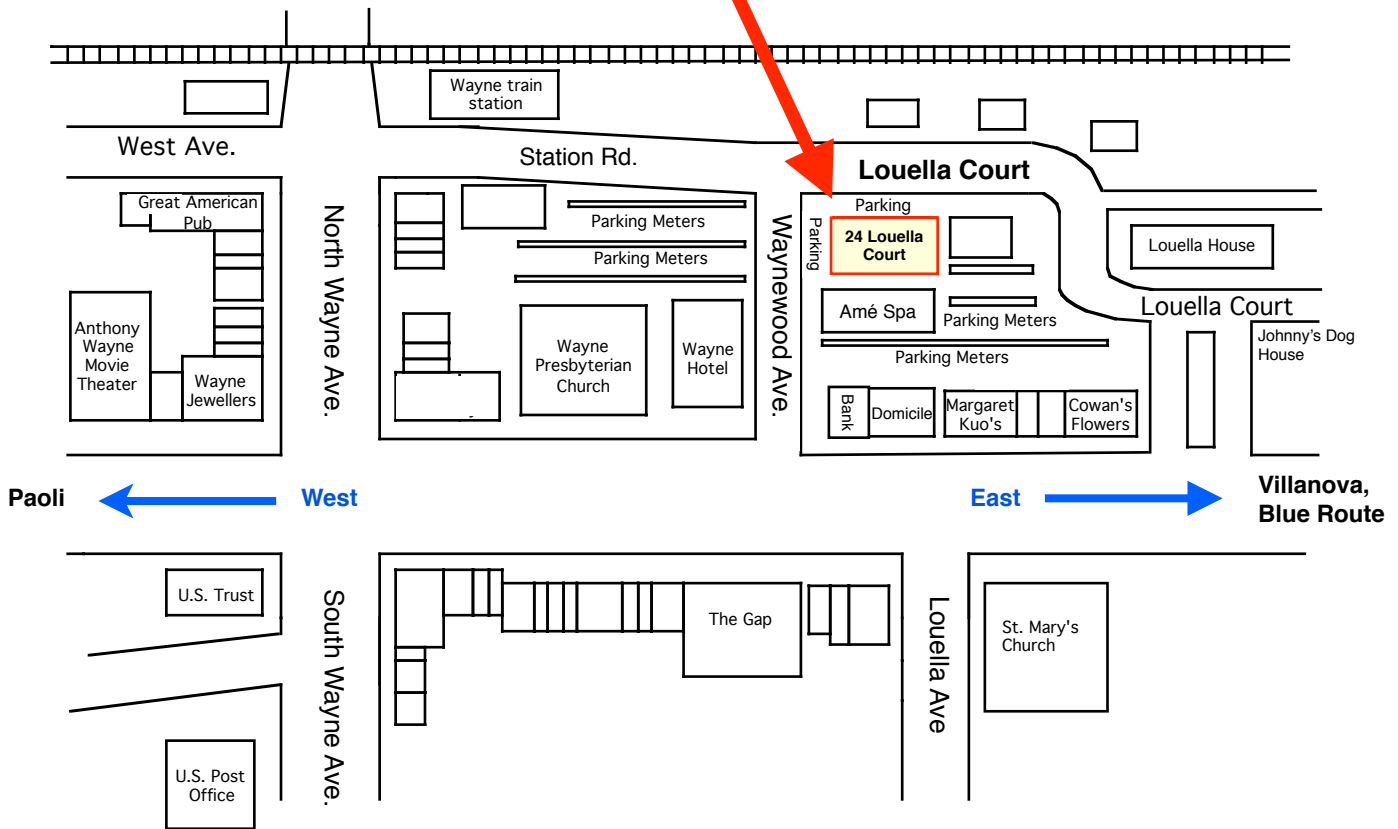
